SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Applicants must reside in North Carolina or South Carolina.
2. Applicants must be enrolled in a college, university or high school seniors who have been admitted to a college or university and will enroll in the Fall 2017 semester.
3. Applicants attending 2-Year Colleges will be eligible for a \$500 Scholarship Award, and Applicants attending 4-Year Colleges or Universities will be eligible for a \$1,000 Scholarship Award.
4. The complete application AND a current transcript must be sent to either one of the following addresses:

5. Applications must be received no later than **April 15, 2017**. The application package must include the completed award application, release form and essay to be considered for the scholarship.
6. The maximum award per student per calendar year is \$1,000.
7. All awards are paid directly to the school where the student is enrolled.
8. Winners will be notified by **May 1, 2017**.
9. Winners must be present at the 2017 PIE Fundraising Gala – Charlotte Region on **Saturday, September 23, 2017** for recognition as a scholarship award recipient. Winners will receive two complementary tickets to attend the Gala.
10. Immediate family members of the PIE Board of directors and scholarship committee members are not eligible to participate.
